- Wellbeing SIG (W-SIG)
- Prevocational SIG (P-SIG)
- Vocational SIG (V-SIG)

Interested representatives should be able to demonstrate the following attributes in relation to the specific SIG:

- Previous advocacy, policy, and/or professional experience.
- Involvement with State and Territory AMAs and/or other medical stakeholder organisations.

Appointments shall be made considering diversity in membership including gender, geography, stage of training, and specialty.

Appointments will be for a 12-month period with an option to extend for a further 12 months.
