All over Australia, female doctors are not only smashing the glass ceiling, but shattering stereotypes and disrupting the status quo.


When I started my general surgery training back home in the United States, I was the only woman and only African-American in my program. My hospital had no female surgeons of any specialty, so I went through years of training without a woman mentor.

However, I had been mentored all my life by a very strong woman – my mother, who after retirement received her PhD in education at age 69 from the University of Oklahoma, which had not allowed black students when she was younger, and went on to become Vice President of a university. My mother instilled in me a sense that I could do anything, bring about change and make an impact.

> In my first year of medical school, my sister was diagnosed with breast cancer. That experience sparked my interest in surgical oncology, specifically breast and oncoplastic surgery. Challenges in delivering surgical care ignited interest in innovation and led to co-inventing radioactive seed localisation for breast lesions.

> > As October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month, all proceeds from our raffle today will go to Restore more, a non-profit organisation dedicated to supporting and funding reconstructive surgery for regionally disadvantaged women facing breast cancer challenges.


