Earlier this week, the Queensland Government announced that it will continue to fund annual influenza (flu) vaccination for all Queenslanders in 2025.

The 2025 Free Flu Vaccination Program will commence on 1 March 2025 and conclude on 30 September 2025. The program will utilise the same funding model as 2024, where providers are reimbursed \$25.00 (excluding GST) for each privately purchased influenza vaccine dose administered.

Further information, including frequently asked questions, will be available to assist consumers and vaccination service providers in the coming weeks and months.

An evaluation of Queensland's Free Flu Vaccination Program will be undertaken in 2025, prior to any decision being made regarding its future in 2026 and beyond.

We look forward to working with you to implement this important program.
