Business of the Meeting

Notice is hereby given that a meeting of members will be held at 7:00 pm on Wednesday 3 December 2025 at Barton and online for the purposes of considering and if thought fit passing the following resolutions:

- 1. As an ordinary resolution, to ratify the Deed of Transfer between the company and the Australian Medical Association Limited.
- 2. As a special resolution, that the company be wound up voluntarily.
