EPA 2

Theme: Acutely unwell patient

Title: Recognise, assess, escalate appropriately, and provide immediate management to deteriorating and acutely unwell patients.

Focus & context: In any clinical context - key: 1.recognise, 2.act immediately, 3.escalate

Description: Activity requires the ability to:

1.recognise clinical deterioration or acutely unwell patient2.respond by initiating immediate management, including BLS3.seek appropriate assistance, including following local process for escalation of care

4.communicate critical information...

Behaviours:	Performwith supervision at distance	Not ready to perform with supervision at distance
Domain 2: Practitioner	Patient management Initiates a timely structured approach management and seeks appropriate assistance	Patient managementDoes not seek appropriate assistance including inappropriate delay in escalating
