REASON: Arrotex Pharmaceuticals Pty Ltd (Arrotex) has initiated a retail level recall of

Various bufexamac-containing topical products due to an identified low risk

of serious skin reactions, following a recent TGA review.

There have been rare reports of serious skin reactions following use of bufexamac, including generalised acute contact dermatitis, erythema multiforme-like reactions and acute generalised exanthematous pustulosis; when severe, these conditions can lead to scarring, a need for skin grafts and

permanent disability.
